We proudly claim the provenance of using Gloucestershire sourced ingredients wherever possible, however, we must be realistic when that comes to offering high quality wines. We do, of course, sell Gloucestershire wines, produced at the family owned Three Choirs Vineyard in Newent, that is just 16 miles from here. Please give them a go, they are excellent value, and you are supporting our counties' producers.

Over and above that, we purchase world wines from the excellent, family owned, local wine importers Talking Wines in Cirencester, just 24 miles away, knowing the money we spend with them goes towards employing local people. They purchase from independent wineries and you will not see these wines in the supermarkets. Of particular note are the three Villa Blanche wines on our list, sourced from the Languedoc region, and made by Calmel & Joseph. These 'Grand Vins' are multi award winners, distinctive and elegant, and would demand double the price were they made in Burgundy. The colour of the Syrah is a thing to behold and the 'chewiness' of the Chardonnay is a food paring triumph. Please think about spending that little bit more. It will bring you back for another bottle on another day.

White Wines

Los Tres Curas Sauvignon Blanc is a fresh, vibrant Chilean Sauvignon packed with tropical fruits and white flower aromas.

Vintage: 2020 Grape: Sauvignon Blanc Region: Central Valley, Chile ABV: 13%

Allamanda Pinot Grigio is a light, easy-drinking Pinot Grigio. Fresh with a hint of citrus. Crisp and delicate on the palate with some honeyed fruit balanced by lemony acidity, minerality and a fresh, dry finish.

Coleridge Hill is a crisp, refreshing wine with distinctly English hedgerow aromas and hints of crisp apple, fragrant elderflower and freshly cut grass. The ripe fruit flavours, balanced acidity and subtle residual sugar combine to create a refreshing wine, perfect on its own or with fish dishes.

Villa Blanche Viognier is a beautiful, rounded Viognier with notes of peach, apricot and citrus with delicious mouthfeel and freshness. This grape is on the up, and the winery is a Harpers Wine Star of 2021.

Villa Blanche Chardonnay is a stunning award winning Chardonnay from the Languedoc. Floral and apple aromas with lovely texture in the mouth and a full satisfying finish. Peach and apricot flavours and perfectly balanced. Pure white velvet.

Makutu Sauvignon Blanc is a classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Gooseberry and grassy aromas followed by a rich palate of gooseberries and tropical fruits.

Red Wines

Los Tres Curas Merlot is a fruity medium-bodied wine with plum and blackcurrant fruits and a hint of spice.

Vintage: 2019 Grape: Merlot Region: Central Valley, Chile ABV: 13%

Vista Sierra Malbec is a fresh easy-drinking Malbec from high altitude vineyards in Mendoza. Bright forest fruits and plum flavours with a smooth finish. Forest fruits and black plum with hints of milk chocolate. This wine has a bright and crunchy fruit palate with supple tannins and a moreish finish.

Carlotta Sangiovese is a smooth fruity wine from Puglia in the south of Italy. Easy drinking with black cherry fruit and a smooth finish.

Villa Blanche Syrah is a full-bodied, rich Syrah with blackcurrant and blackberry aromas. Full in the mouth with pure ripe fruit and beautiful silky tannins.

Ravens Hill is a deep, ruby coloured red wine full of ripe blackberry and cherry fruit on the nose with a subtle hint of lightly toasted oak from the American oak Barrel ageing, from the beautiful Gloucestershire countryside.

Paternina Monte Haro Rioja is a classic Rioja style from one of Rioja's oldest producers Federico Paternina. Red berry fruits, medium weight with creamy notes and good structure.

Rose and Bubbly

Allamanda Pinot Grigio Rose is a Pinot Grigio made with a touch of Pinot Noir adding depth to this light and refreshing style with subtle cherry and summer fruit flavours.

Vintage: 2019 Grape: Pinot Grigio, Pinot Noir Region: Venetie, Italy ABV: 12.5%

Ponte di Rialto Prosecco is a lively, crisp Italian sparkling wine which is aromatic and fresh with light apple and pear flavours and a floral hint. It has a dry, wonderfully refreshing finish.
